KPHA offers multiple opportunities for youth members! Make sure you take advantage!

Youth Show for Reduced Fees: At many of our shows all youth exhibitors pay for is their stall and office charges! Check official show bills for pricing schedules.

Scholarship Opportunities: Scholarships are available from APHA at both the Zone and National levels to AJPMA members. In addition, KPHA offers two \$500 scholarships each year to our youth members, the Art Carpenter Memorial Scholarship and the KPHA Scholarship. Art Carpenter was involved in the promotion and judging of Paint horses, also educating the youth in the benefits and camaraderie of showing and caring for Paints. The Kansas Paint Horse Association is proud to continue his work through the scholarship founded in his name and to add a scholarship of its own to further aid its members in achieving their educational goals.

Both the Art Carpenter and KPHA scholarships were established to assist students in the Kansas Paint Horse Association in achieving their educational goals. The scholarships, in the amount of \$500, must be applied for annually and you must be a member of KPHA. The Art Carpenter scholarship is available for use at a junior college or university, while the KPHA scholarship may be used by an adult returning to school and for vocational trade schools. Applications are due July 1 of each year and will be awarded with a formal presentation at the annual awards banquet. Leadership Opportunities: There are many opportunities for leadership experience with the Kansas Paint Horse Youth Association. Participating in a leadership role in our youth club as President, Vice President, Treasure or Secretary is a great opportunity for experience and is very valuable on resumes, college applications, and résumés!

Multiple Levels of Competition: Everyone is welcome! Please don't feel worried if you are a beginner or are afraid of advancing to breed level competition. Our shows offer something for all ages and all experience levels of youth. Our Leadline classes are offered for our youngest exhibitors aged 3-8. Walk-trot classes are offered for youth 5-11. Novice youth classes are for those youth who have not earned more than 10 points in a particular class (see APHA website for complete Novice eligibility). Then of course we have our regular youth 14-18 classes. Youth can also show in our all-breed classes. KPHA offers something for everyone in a relaxed environment regardless of experience level! Come have fun with us!!

Year End Awards: KPHA offers year end awards for youth in leadline, walk-trot, novice youth, youth 14-18 and all-breed classes.

New for Year End Awards!!

"Super Yearling" will be awarded to the High Point Yearling exhibiting in their perspective Halter class, Yearling In-Hand Trail and Yearling In-Hand Trail. Exhibitor/Horse must abide by all current year end award qualifications.

Also new for this year! Exhibitors will get to select their own year-end awards in 2013! An awards catalog will be available at the end of the show season with a variety of award choices!

APHA CLASS FEES:

Fees noted below are for all shows except August Hot R N Heck Circuit and KS State Fair.

Tack stalls, stalls for horses not showing: \$50 /weekend or \$30 per day.
Jumpout: \$20 per day.

YOUTH APHA CLASSES ARE FREE!!!*

All youth pay is for stall and office charges. \$42.00 per day! Cross over to all APHA Classes Free same horse/rider (If the horse crosses over into the Amateur or open divisions, then the corresponding flat fee will then apply.)

*Fees for August show will be \$75 per day.

AMATUER/OPEN

Amateur and Open Fee's include 1 stall and office charges*. No cross over fees from Amateur to open.

\$65.00 flat fee for 1 class per day, per horse.

\$75.00 flat fee for 2 classes per day, per horse.

\$110.00 flat fee for 3 or more classes per day, per horse.

*Fees for August show Am/Open 1 class \$75, 2 classes \$85, or 3 & up classes \$120 can cross over
