Scholarship Opportunities

Scholarships are available from APHA at both the Zone and National levels to AJPHA members. In addition, KPHA offers two \$500 scholarships each year to our youth members, the Art

Carpenter Memorial Scholarship and the KPHA Scholarship. Art Carpenter was involved in the promotion and judging of Paint horses, also educating the youth in the benefits and camaraderie of showing and caring for Paints. The Kansas Paint Horse Association is proud to continue his work through the scholarship founded in his name and to add a scholarship of its own to further aid its members in achieving their educational goals.

Both the Art Carpenter and KPHA scholarships were established to assist students in the Kansas Paint Horse Association in achieving their educational goals. The scholarships, in the amount of \$500, must be applied for annually and you must be a member of KPHA. The Art Carpenter scholarship is available for use at a junior college or university, while the KPHA scholarship may be used by an adult returning to school and for vocational trade schools. Applications are due July 1 of each year and will be awarded with a formal presentation at the annual awards banquet. APHA 2015 Updates - Paint Horse Journal – apha.com

A full list of passed rules as well as the 2015 *APHA Official Rule Book* are available online at apha.com. However, below are four new rules that will make big impacts on the association:

Show Lease Program: Beginning January 1, show lease certificates will be issued to individual Amateur or Youth members who file a show lease form with APHA; the lessee's immediate family members are also allowed to exhibit the horse. The lessee must be responsible for all expenses relating to the horse. All leases expire on December 31, unless terminated before that date, and must be renewed annually with the applicable performance lease fee.

Membership Requirements: Starting in January, horse owners must be current APHA members for their horses to compete in APHA-approved classes. Additionally, all exhibitors must have a current, individual membership to be eligible to show. Joint and/or farm or ranch membership will no longer satisfy the membership requirement. Details and examples of this change are available online.

2-Year-Old Longe Line: Starting in 2015, APHA will offer 2-Year-Old Longe Line for horses that have not been shown in under saddle classes. This class will offer extended opportunities for young horses to showcase their performance potential.

Expanded Paint Horse Championship Shows: In response to two successful trial events in 2014, APHA is excited to roll out its popular Paint Horse Championships at events around the country in 2015. The first event—the Southeast Paint Horse Championship, presented in conjunction with the Zone 9 Southern Classic—takes place February 14-16, 2015, in Jacksonville, Florida.
