## **KPHA Youth Member Jacob Grinstead Awarded AjPHA Youth Member of the Year**

During the recent American Junior Paint Horse Association (AjPHA ) Year-end Awards Banquet, Kansas Paint Horse Association member, Jacob Grinstead was awarded AjPHA Youth Member of the Year. Jacob and his parents, Jerry and Sheri Grinstead, attended the Youth World Championship Show in Ft. Worth, Texas to receive the accolade. Jacob was presented a custom designed Gist Award Buckle and \$ 1000 scholarship by APHA President Susie Shaw for his efforts. The winner will also be recognized in the *Paint Horse Connection* and *Paint Horse Journal*.

Under the award description, the AjPHA Youth Member of the Year is described as a well-rounded individual who exemplifies the spirit of community involvement, volunteer work, scholarship and leadership. Jacob Grinstead was chosen based on the following records of involvement:
