## **High Point Buckles and Prizes Awarded**

Buckles will be awarded to the High Point Youth and the High Point Novice Youth exhibiting during the KPHA 2 day show at the Kansas State Fair. Youth buckles are sponsored by Stacie Lundquist.

The High Point Walk/Trot Amateur, Novice Amateur and Amateur High Point exhibitors showing at the 2 day Kansas State Fair KPHA show will be awarded buckles sponsored by the Grinstead Family and KPHA.

A High Point 19 and Over All Breed Award; and 19 and Under All Breed High Point Award will be given for the 2 day KPHA/KSF event.

High Point qualifying exhibitors must enter in a halter class to be eligible for a High Point award.

Random drawings will be held during the Kansas State Fair/Kansas Paint Horse Assn. Show.

### **2018 Kansas State Fair Notes:**

If you are planning on attending our Kansas State Fair shows on September 11 and 12, 2018 you will want to request stall reservations online or in person very soon at [www.kansasstatefair.com](http://www.kansasstatefair.com). To prevent issues during check-in, it is my suggestion that you make copies of any entries, stall reservations, parking passes or other services requested. In addition, you may call several weeks prior to the fair to ensure your information was received and is accurate. When completing KSF forms, be as specific as possible regarding the number of stalls you wish to be assigned as this will eliminate confusion at check-in. The stall office is very good about trying to accommodate everyone's wishes but you will need to communicate accurately your order for stalls. If you plan to exhibit at the Quarter/SCSHA or Pinto Show on Sunday and Monday of the fair and wish to carry stalls over to the Paint Show; or any shows scheduled later in the week, please make notes of such on the entry form as applicable.

NOTE: Kansas State Fair premiums will be paid to the owner NOT Exhibitor. All paperwork should be filled out with the owner's information. If you have any questions you may call the Kansas State Fair office at 620 669-3600.

### **2018 Kansas State Fair Reminders:**

This year the Kansas State Fair is allowing a Gypsy Vanner Demonstration to be held in the Expo 2 Building during both days of our show. KPHA leadership was not aware of this activity until our August 9th meeting with KSF staff. It does appear we will have some discretion as to when they perform and will make every effort to minimize the effect on our exhibitors.

Livestock check-in will be in the same location and entail the same procedure as last year.

Electrical hook-ups in the lot east of the grandstand (Tan Lot) are available to horse exhibitors. Cost is \$ 40/day and includes permits for vehicle/trailer parking. (Information is on the KSF website or please feel free to contact me for assistance).

If you did not order a sufficient number of hang tags, shavings etc. for the fair show---additional purchases can be made in the stalling office during the fair.

2018 Kansas State Fair Grand and Reserve Champion halter winners are asked to visit the photographer before leaving the fairgrounds (for KSF documentation).

Premiums: Exhibitors and/or owners MUST have a W-9 turned into the office before the end of the show. If stalling is completed on-line, I was told the W-9 can be completed also on-line at that time. A W-9 MUST be completed EVERY YEAR for the KSF Equine office in order to correctly issue premium checks.

### **2018 Year End Awards Reminder**

Our third KPHA weekend show is scheduled for September 11 and 12, 2018. If your goal is to earn year-end class champion/reserve champion or year-end High Point/Reserve High Point awards---REMEMBER you must attend ½ + 1 of the KPHA shows offered in 2018. (The April NPHC show counts in our calculations, as well as, the KPHA May and June show points).
