

### Be ready at A

3. Trot in a half circle to judge
4. Stop and set up for inspection
5. When dismissed, perform a 540° turn
6. Trot around B as shown
7. When even with judge, stop and perform a 180° turn
8. Back one horse length
9. Turn 90° and walk to exit



#### Be ready at A

1. Trot 1/3 of line and build to an extended trot to the judge
2. Stop and perform a 1 3/4 turnWalk then trot in a tight half circle and in a straight line across your original line
3. Stop and back in an "L" shape as shown then perform a 90° turn
4. Trot in a half circle to judge
5. Stop and set up
6. Inspection
7. When dismissed, perform a 180° and walk away

2. Back approximately 1 horse length
3. Walk to B
4. At B, posting trot serpentine to D (changing diagonals at C)
5. At D, continue posting trot curve back towards C
6. At C, sitting trot until even with B



### Be ready at A

- 1. Back one horse length
  2. Walk to B
  3. Trot left diagonal to C
  4. Canter left lead to D
  5. Change leads, canter circle right
  6. Sitting trot corner to C
  7. Posting trot right diagonal back to B

Pattern is complete when you pass B





### Be ready facing cone A

1. 90° forehand turn to left
2. Back approximately 1 horse length
3. Walk to B
4. At B, sitting trot to C
5. At C, canter left lead to D
6. At D, trot curve back towards C on right diagonal
7. At C, change diagonals and posting trot back until even with B

Pattern is complete when you cross B



- 1. Walk

- Trot
   Extend the trot; At the top of the arena, stop
   360° turn to the left
   Left lead ½ circle, lope to the center
   Change leads (simple or flying)
   Right lead ½ circle
   Extended lope up the long side of the arena (right lead)
   Collect back to a lope around the top of the arena and back to center
   Break down to an extended trot
   Walk over poles
   Stop and back



   Canter left lead with speed, stop, walk out





#### Pattern can be trot-in or lope-in

- 1. Beginning on the left lead complete two circles left, the first small and slow, the second large and fast; Change 2. Complete two circles right, the first small and slow, the second large and fast; Change leads at the center 3. Begin a large circle to the left but do not close it. Run down the right side of the arena past center and roll bac 4. Continue around the end of the arena to run down left side past center and roll back left, no hisitation 5. Run past the middle marker, stop, back up 10 feet; 1/4 turn right, 1/2 turn left, 1/4 turn right; Hesitate to comp



Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles to the left: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change le 3. Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the 4. Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback - no hesitation. 5. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to the center of the arena or at least 10 feet (3 meter 6. Complete four spins to the right.

7. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.

Rider may drop bridle to the designated judge.
